## CUTS and SPECIMENS

All exhibits MUST be in place by 2.00pm on Friday 18th October 2019

Judging COMMENCES at 2.30pm Friday 18th October 2019.

Exhibitors are responsible for their own exhibits after 5.00 pm on Show Day.

### No Entry Fee, No Prize Money

#### Exhibitors please note:

Exhibits will be disqualified if other than stated number of specimens.

Exhibit cards MUST be attached to exhibits.

Cuts and Specimens in each class are to be in one container unless otherwise specified.

Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.

#### Definitions

Specimen: One bloom only on a bare or leafy stalk according to species. No buds. No laterals.

Cut: More than one bloom or floret, buds, with leaves and laterals according to species.

Distinct: same type, but different colour.

NND: not necessarily distinct.

TRUE GERANIUM: Trailing plant with pink, mauve or blue five petals flower – common name “Cranesbill”.

### CONTAINERS WILL BE PROVIDED

#### Class:

1. Collection of Old Fashioned/Heritage Roses
2. Heritage Rose-one with foliage (including David Austin)
3. Rose, one specimen
4. Rose, one variety, three stages, bud, perfect and full blown
5. Rose, Polyanthus or Floribunda, one cut, must have more than one bloom on stem
6. Camellia, one specimen with foliage, any variety
7. Poppies, six specimens any varieties
8. Sweet Peas, three stems
  
9. Pansies or violas, three specimens with collars, separate containers, NND
10. True Geranium (common name Cranesbill), single, one head with own leaf
11. Geranium, double, one head with own leaf
12. Ivy leaf Pelargonium, Ivy leaf, one head with own leaf.
13. Pelargonium, one head with own leaf
14. Fuchsia, single, one cut
15. Fuchsia, double, one cut
16. Daisies, three specimens any variety
17. Two Garden Flowers, ANY two different varieties, Flowering, Native, Shrub- separate containers, named if possible.
18. Iris, three Stalks Tall Bearded, distinct, separate containers
19. Iris, Tall Bearded, one stalk
20. Iris, Louisiana, one stalk
21. Three Iris florets, no buds, stems not to exceed 5cm, separate containers
